Parish Council updates, what's been happening in the last couple of months:

- Stile to Public Pathway on A5013 Hidderley's Field has been strimmed. Access bridge across river reinforced.
- Blocked gully between Bridgeford and Creswell cleared.
- Wreaths laid at Perrin and Harry Kerr memorials. New flag installed at Harry Kerr memorial.
- Grass verge on Strawson's development cut back.
- We are requesting more timely updates from the developers in relation to the petrol station within the Grove.

Future Plans/Ideas:

- New bus shelter agreed.
- Solar powered AED agreed.
- Bleed control kit, awaiting formal approval.
- 2025 Christmas meal for senior residents/ Children's party been suggested indication of interest required. Local venue to be agreed.

- 5. Environment would you like to see the current benches upgraded? Would you like to see raised planters in the grove?

6. Over to you – what would you like to see in the future? Please share your ideas and we promise that we will get back to you and raise these at the Parish Council meetings on your behalf, should you not wish/be able to attend yourself.
