**TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC
A5013 Creswell Grove and Creswell Roundabout At Junction With M6
Stafford**

NOTICE is hereby given that Staffordshire County Council on 05 May 2026 intends to make an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in the following:

A5013 Creswell Grove, Stafford - in a **south easterly direction only** starting at a point approximately 550 metres north-west of its junction with M6 Junction 14

Creswell Roundabout at junction with M6 - at its south west quadrant.

unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works; or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

The order will come into operation on 11th May 2026 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 29th January 2027.

The works will be completed in phases which are subject to change:

It is anticipated that the A5013 Creswell One Way closure will be in operation between 11th May 2026 and 18 November 2026

It is anticipated the Creswell Rbt closure at the junction with M6 will be in operation between 19 November 2026 until 29 January 2027

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the S278 works (including dropped crossing installations, surfacing works, kerb line and drainage works and removal of the splitter island works, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
